Today's Challenge: Let it slide!

The name of today's challenge is Let it Slide!

This is a two part problem. In part 1 you will have 4 minutes to build your solutions and practice. In Part 2 you will have 3 minutes to accumulate score.

Your problem is to build a slide for a ping pong ball, golf ball, small bouncing ball, and large bouncing ball. For the purpose of this problem, a slide is a device that transports a ball from a height to the ground. To be considered successful, the ball must stay on slide until it contacts the floor. The slide must also be free standing.

If a ball should fall off the slide during testing, the team has the option to re-test that ball or move on. Only balls that successfully slide from a team created high to the bottom will be scored.

Team members must place their slide in the 1ft by 1ft designated area.

Score will be as follows:

Each ball that successfully will score the points based on the height of structure. For example, if the structure is 5inches high, each ball is worth five points.

A free standing slide will be worth half its height. Half inches will be rounded down. For example, if a team's slide is 5 inches high, the team will receive 2 points.

Penalties: Team will be penalized for violated the spirit of the problem.

Creativity of the solution will receive 1-20

Teamwork will receive 1-20
